Why is Finland in the news?

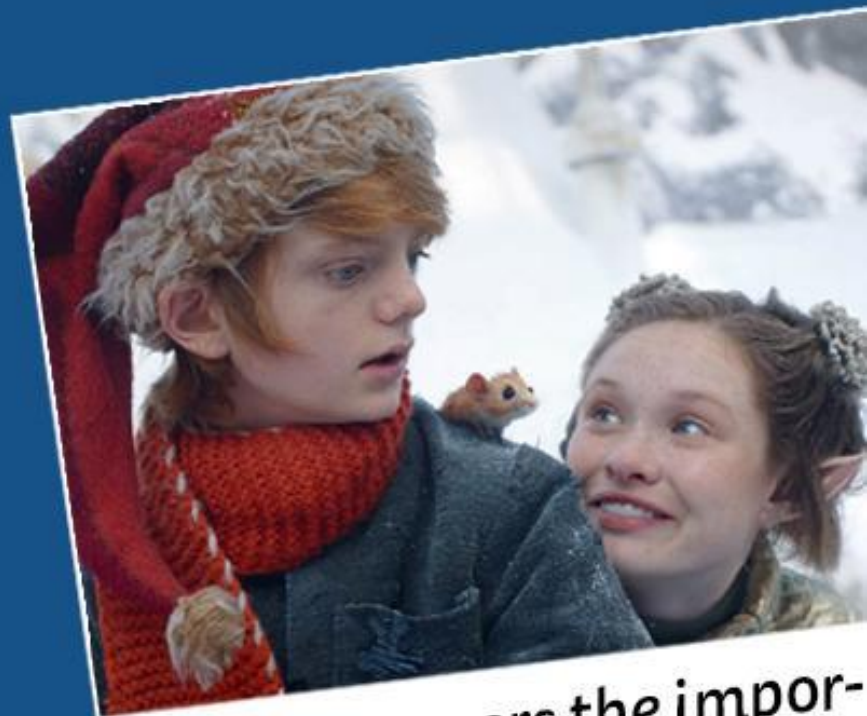
Because there is a new film, A Boy Called Christmas, in which the main character...
