is Naypyidaw.

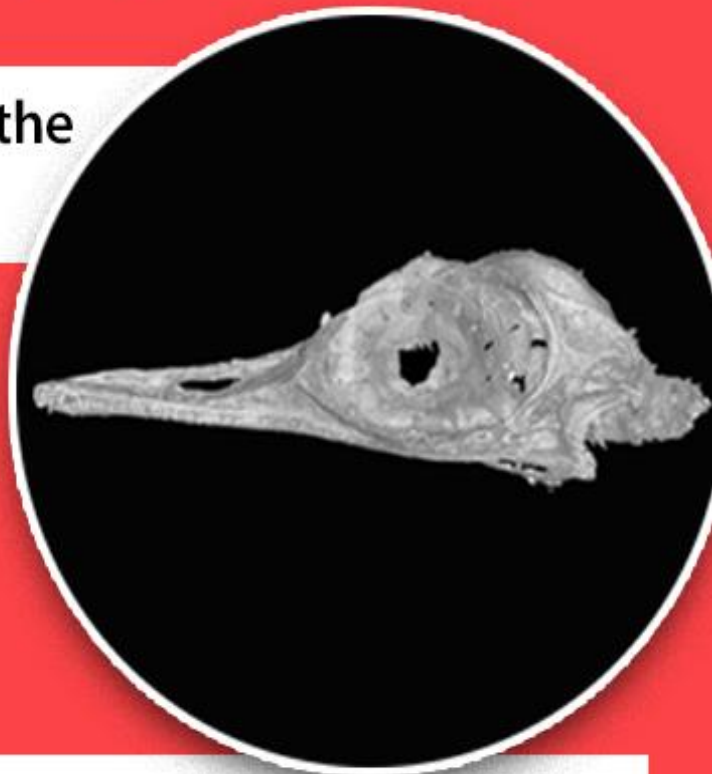
