Transition to Secondary School

Dear Parents / Carers.

This is an extremely important time of the year for our Year 6 pupils as they start to think about the move to "big school" and the exciting challenges that lie ahead. We wanted to take this opportunity to share our plans for supporting your child's transition to their new school.

We are continuing to participate in the **Maidstone Schools Transition Project** which joins a number of Primary and Secondary schools in partnership in order to support your child's happy, and well-informed transfer to their named Secondary School. This is further supported by the Specialist Teaching and Learning Service (STLS) so that all schools are guided by best practice and that the needs of all groups of children are represented.

During the course of next term, we will be working with our Secondary School partners in order to create a profile of your child: this will enable them to better understand who they are as a learner and what they may need in terms of support when they arrive in September. The children will be completing a questionnaire in school so that our Secondary Schools may tailor their transition work according to the outcomes of this questionnaire.

The transition partnership has arranged a **Virtual Parents' Information Session on 28 April at 7pm**. This will be managed on the Microsoft Teams platform; we will write again closer to the time in order to provide more details and the link to access the meeting. We will keep you informed once government guidance changes. In the meantime, I have attached a "Getting Ready for Secondary School" document that I hope you find useful as a starting point for conversations with your child. A document with links to all Secondary School Transition websites is also attached for your information.









Miss Flisher and Mr Biddlecombe will be working with the children using a project booklet that will prepare the children for life in Secondary School in many ways; timetables, using public transport, visiting the school canteen, expectations, code of conduct etc.
